Before you dive into this new adventure, we have a few requirements* to ensure everyone in Scouting is safe.

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Register via MyScouts.ca.



Read and sign our Code of Conduct!

The Code of Conduct outlines your willingness to comply with Scouts Canada's mission and principles. This agreement is **reviewed and re-signed on an annual basis in MyScouts**.



Complete Scouting Fundamentals and Respect in Sport!

Understand our youth program and how to manage bullying, abuse, harassment, and discrimination. Take the courses at your own pace while you wait for your PRC/VSS.



Ask for a Police Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Search. This safety requirement is provided **locally**.

Manitoba and Nova Scotia only: Request a **Child Abuse Registry Check!** Do this as soon as possible because processing times vary throughout the year.

Get the Group Commissioner's Approval!

The endorsement of the lead Scouter in your group and it will be added to your MyScouts account at any time during onboarding.



Reference Checks. Supply five references. We only need three "passed" reference checks. If you didn't include them when you signed up, your Group Commissioner will contact you.



Rock your Interview! You'll be contacted to schedule a one-hour-interview with your Group Commissioner and another Scouter. **Ask questions** about your new role!



Obtain Council Approval! When you have completed your journey, your screening will be confirmed as complete, and Council Approval will be provided.
