Process: Creating a Holding Section/Group in MyScouts

Confirm What You Need

- Decide if you need:
 - **A new Section added to an existing Group**
 - **Or**
 - **a new Council “holding” Group** created (for new Scouters to register and start their screening/onboarding until a Group is formalized/a satellite Group is found)

Who to Contact

Primary Contact:

- **Member Services Team via the Help Centre**
Submit a request at [Scouts Canada Help Centre](#) or email helpcentre@scouts.ca

Include your Council/Scouting Relationship Manager (if applicable) on the message for awareness.

What to Include in Your Request

When submitting your ticket or email, clearly provide:

- **Subject:** “Request to Open a New [Section/Holding Group] in MyScouts”
- **Council name**
- **Group name (if existing)** or request for a **Council Holding Group**
- **Requested Section(s):** (e.g. Beavers, Cub, Scouts)
- **Location (City/Community)**
- **Anticipated Day and Time**
- **Section Contact Person** (Group Commissioner, Scouting Relationship Manager, etc.)
- **Any specific details about when it would be needed to be created/opened by**
