Supplies needed are based on activities chosen

General Supplies

- Tables (recommended 2-5 – one for registration, and 1-4 for activities)
- Tablecloths (1 per table)
- Scouts Canada pop-up tent (number depends on access to undercover area and weather)
- Scouts Canada banner(s) (**Tip:** Ask your Council Team for Scouts Canada branded items)
- Sandwich board sign
- Printed signs for each station (**Tip:** Receive 20% off printing at Staples with code: 8402254869)
- Sign-in sheet(s)
- Name tags for volunteers
- Flyers, marketing materials, brochures (**Tip:** [Scouts Canada D.A.M](#))
- Scouts Canada swag
- Small snacks & drinks (nut-free granola bars/juice boxes, etc.)
- Garbage/recycling/compost bins
